



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing will be held at 7:00 PM on Thursday, August 18, 2022 at City Hall, 312 Esplanade Street, at which time citizens may be heard on the tentative proposed property tax rates proposed to be set by Hollister, Missouri, a political subdivision. The tax rates shall be set to produce the revenues which the budget for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2022, shows to be required from the property tax. Each tax rate is determined by dividing the amount of revenue required by the current assessed valuation, less estimated uncollectible. The result is multiplied by 100 so the tax rate will be expressed in cents per \$100. assessed valuation.
